

Below you will find the grade book key that all teachers will be using in their grade books. This key should help you understand your student's grade book's in a better way. If you see any of the following codes in your child's grade books this is what they mean:

- 0-MC = assignment has not been turned in yet but they can still turn it in for full or partial credit (full or partial credit is the discretion of the teacher) The zero will be reflected in their grade.
- M = student has not handed in this assignment, but they can still hand the assignment in for full or partial credit. (Full or partial credit is up to the discretion of the teacher)
- 0-M = the assignment has not been handed in and the student can no longer hand the assignment in for any credit.
- scoreL = shows the score received on an assignment but notes that it was turned in late. (I.E.... 10-L means the student received a 10 on the assignment but it was turned in late.)
- A = student was absent for this assignment but they can still turn it in for full credit, if turned in within time frame set by teacher.
- 0-UN = student will receive a 0 (zero) because of an unexcused absence
- EX = student is excused from this assignment and does not have to complete it. This score will not count against his or her grade.

**** NOTE**** Grades are kept in our online system for 1st – 12th grade students. Kindergarten students will not have grades show up on parent connect.
